<p>Nebuchadnezzar's dream about a tree had a second fulfilment</p>	<p>The dream had a single interpretation, which is explicitly stated</p> <p>Daniel 4:24, 25: This is the interpretation, O king; it is the decree of the Most High that must befall my lord the king. ²⁵ You will be driven away from among men, and your dwelling will be with the beasts of the field, and you will be given vegetation to eat just like bulls; and you will become wet with the dew of the heavens, and seven times will pass over you, until you know that the Most High is Ruler in the kingdom of mankind and that he grants it to whomever he wants.</p> <p>Daniel 4:28-33: All of this befell King Neb·u·chad·nez'zar. ²⁹ Twelve months later he was walking on the roof of the royal palace of Babylon. ³⁰ The king was saying: "Is this not Babylon the Great that I myself have built for the royal house by my own strength and might and for the glory of my majesty?" ³¹ While the word was yet in the king's mouth, a voice came down from the heavens: "To you it is being said, O King Neb·u·chad·nez'zar, 'The kingdom has gone away from you, ³² and from mankind you are being driven away. With the beasts of the field your dwelling will be, and you will be given vegetation to eat just like bulls, and seven times will pass over you, until you know that the Most High is Ruler in the kingdom of mankind and that he grants it to whomever he wants.'" ³³ At that moment the word was fulfilled on Neb·u·chad·nez'zar. He was driven away from mankind, and he began to eat vegetation just like bulls, and his body became wet with the dew of the heavens, until his hair grew long just like eagles' feathers and his nails were like birds' claws.</p>
